Awards of Merit

The judge may select, at his/her discretion, up to 10% of the Champions entered in Best of Breed, not to exceed 5 Awards of Merit, to the superior quality specimens not including those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Select Dog/Bitch.

Special Attraction

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor in Show will be chosen from the first place winners of the Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy and Bred-by-Exhibitor Adult classes. Best BBE in Show will receive One free Litter Registration offered by the American Kennel Club.

Classifications (each specialty)

The following regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Puppy, 6 months & under 9 months Puppy, 9 months & under 12 months 12-18 Months Novice Amateur-Owner-Handler Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Bred By Exhibitor Adult American Bred Open WINNERS

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition

The following non-regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Entries in these classes need not be intact.

Veterans - Both Specialties

Entries in these classes need not be intact.

Veteran 7-9 Years Class - 7 Years and Under 9 Years on the day of the show

Veteran 9-11 Years Class - 9 Years and Under 11 Years on the day of the show

Veteran 11 Years & Over Class - 11 Years and Older on the day of the show

Field Class - National Specialty ONLY

Entries in these classes MUST be intact.

Field Class - For Dogs and Bitches who have an AKC Hunting title.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Specialty Only)

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be (but need not be) entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, and must be entered in the Stud Dog class as an "Additional Class." The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition.

The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class (Two dogs of the same breed, one or more common owner) – The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made. If a dog which is to be part of the Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog using the individual, regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2."

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

Points Available for Reserve

The Spinone Club of America will award at its *National Specialty* a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

AKC Sanctioned 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

One combined class will be offered for Spinoni Italiani that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. There will be a selection of Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy & Best of Opposite Sex to Best 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show. **NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.** You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

GUN DOG AND VETERAN GUN DOG SWEEPSTAKES

This event is designed to highlight and honor those Spinoni that fulfill their breed purpose as "hard working gun dogs" while remaining true to the structure and breed type of the Spinone.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 Entrants need not be entered in any other class at the SCOA National Specialty. All AKC registered dogs, including Champions of Record and spayed and/or neutered dogs/bitches are eligible for competition.

Regular and Veteran Class Qualifications:

Dogs/bitches who have earned an AKC JH, SH or MH title, or a NAVHDA qualifying prize score in NA, UPT, UT, or a VC title.

GUN DOG SWEEPSTAKES ELIGIBILITY

Gun Dog and Veteran Gun Dog Sweepstakes is open to any Spinone Italiano with an AKC Hunting title or NAVHDA Prize or Title. AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTER-NATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for the first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
