AKC National Owner Handler Series Competition

BEST PUPPY: During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy in Breed from the Regular Puppy Dog & Puppy Bitch Classes. This will be done after Best of Breed & Award of Merit judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: A Puppy Class winner is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners. Only First Place Winners in the regular Puppy classes are eligible to compete for Best Puppy.

BEST VETERAN: During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran in Breed from the Non-Regular Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch Classes. This will be done after Best of Breed & Award of Merit judging unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: A Veteran Class Winner is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs not defeated in regular Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Best Veteran.

JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT: At the conclusion of Best of Breed, after picking Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch, the Specialty Judge at his/her discretion may award Rosettes for Awards of Merit to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed entry.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 years · Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 years
Novice Senior 15 & under 18 years · Open Junior 9 & under 12 years
Intermediate 12 & under 15 years
Open Senior 15 & under 18 years · Master Class

Novice Class—Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or members show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class—Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class—Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.

- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. 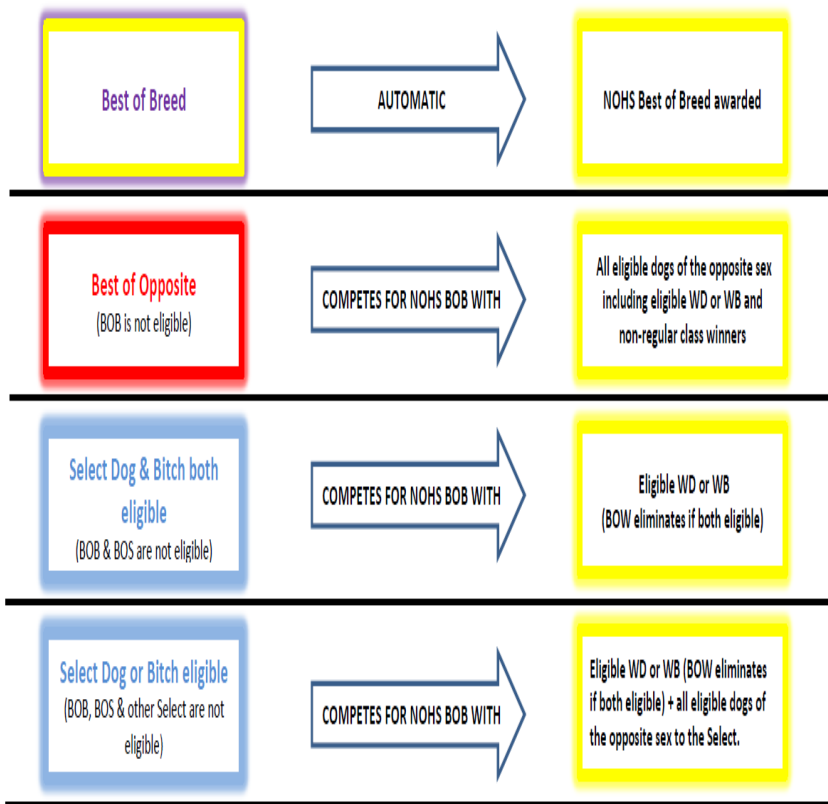

Once the judge has awarded BOB/BOV, BOW, BOS and Selects

- Judge should compare the awards vs. the entries indicated as eligible to compete by an asterisk (*) in the judges book
- Determine by the flow chart which of entries eligible for NOHS(*) may have been eliminated by the awards (BOB, BOS, BOW, Selects) and which should remain in the ring for the designation of NOHS Best of Breed



If none of the above awards (BOB, BOS, Select Dog, or Select Bitch) are indicated as eligible, judge is to award NOHS Best of Breed from any eligible dog competing for Best of Breed, including WD and WB. If eligible, BOW eliminates the Winners of the opposite sex automatically.

Dogs must be entered in the NOHS Competition to be eligible for NOHS Best of Breed. (Indicated by an "*(*)")

Only those dogs indicated by an asterisk (*) and eligible to compete for NOHS BOB (entered in BOB, move-ups, 1st place non-regular, WD & WB) are eligible for the NOHS award. Eligible Select DOES NOT automatically eliminate eligible same sex Winners Dog/Bitch.
