

Best of Breed Competition

Amateur-Owner-Handler: (AOH Class Eligibility) For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Bred-By-Exhibitor Class eligibility: (BBE Class Eligibility) All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC. For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. The Person handling the dog must be the person individually registered with American Kennel Club and are owned or co-owned by any of the breeders as of the date of closing entries for this show. The person handling the dog in the class <u>must</u> be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Best of Breed: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Also, dogs that, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose records are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championship is unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date when the dog completed the requirements for a championship, according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until his championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog & Bitch Entries

The first place Winner of each of these classes, if undefeated in the show, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed

Veteran Classes • A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches.

Veteran, Seven, (7)years or older.

Under "AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows," Chapter 11, Section 8, Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

CCCI NATIONAL • CLASSIFICATION & ELIGIBILITY

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Note: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Stud Dog Class • For Stud Dogs and two but not more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Judging will be based on merits of the Get. Although the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. GET MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS, BEST OF BREED, OR SOME OTHER NON-REGULAR CLASS OTHER THAN STUD DOG. The Stud dog unit shall be considered as one entry and require only one entry fee.

The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes at a first entry fee of \$ 28.00, with "Stud Dog" class indicated on the entry form in the Additional class field at an additional cost of \$ 24.00. OR, the Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog class only for a fee **\$28.00**.

Brood Bitch Class • Same as above except Substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

AKC rules Applying to Dog shows, Chapter 11, Section 8, provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and spayed bitches may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class • The Brace Class shall be for two (2) Chow Chows, irrespective of sex, that are similar in appreance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs comprising the Barce <u>must</u> have at least one common owner and <u>must</u> be entered in another Regular or Non-Regular class. An entry form for a dog entered in the Brace Class must indicate the name of the other dog comprising the other half of the brace.

Brace Entry fee is \$28.00 for the <u>unit</u>**.** For each dog entered in the Brace Class, indicate "Brace" in the Additional Entry field of the entry form. If more that one Brace is entered by an indentical owner, the dog comprising each Brace Unit must be designated as "Brace #1" and "Brace #2", Etc, Entry fee is for Each Brace, not each individual dog.

A Brace is defined by AKC as: Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

Team Class • Each Team shall be composed fo four Chow Chows owned by one or more common owner. All dogs competing in Team competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Team must be named at the time of the enrtry and all must be individually entered in another class. Entry fee is \$28.00 for the <u>unit</u>. You can enter each dog seperately, but you must put your <u>TEAM NAME</u>.

CCCI NATIONAL • CLASSIFICATION & ELIGIBILITY

Best Puppy Competition • During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Puppy Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undeafeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Competition • During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undeafeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Best Veteran Competition • During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran class is awarded Best of Winner or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undeafeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Grand Champion Points • Grand Championship points will be awarded to: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch.

3 Point Major Reserve • At the National Specialty, dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

Judge's Award of Merit • Immediately following the Best of Breed competion, the judge may select, at his discretion, up to 10% of the total entires of dog and bitches in the Best of Breed judgeing. These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog/Bitch or Best of Winners. A rosette will be given to each Award of Merit Winner.

Parade of Tile Holders and Champion Chow Chows (Non-competitive) • The Parade of Champions, Titleholders is open to all Chow Chows that are holders of an AKC Champion of Record Title, ROM, and/or and AKC Obedience Title & Rally Title. Each dog will be presented with a Rosette. PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee is \$22.00 The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Chow Chows, six (6) months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. ALL SWEEPSTAKES ENTRANTS MUST ALSO BE ENTERD IN A REGULAR BREED CLASS. Entry fee is in addition to the regular class entry fee. Entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular classes. The sweepstakes class should be entered in the Additional Call field with the age division noted on the same entry used to enter the dog or bitch in the regular class.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Entry fee is \$22.00. The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Chow Chows, seven (7) years of age and older on the date of the show. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Breed Class. If this is the only class in which the dog is entered, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the Dog Show Class field. If it is an additional class, indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with the age division noted in the age division noted in the Additional Class field.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. However, sweepstakes winners do not go on to further placement in the shows as a result of participating in Veteran Sweepstakes.

Same Classes for dogs and bitches Veterans, 7 years & under 9 years • Veterans, 9 years & under 11 years Veterans, 11 years and older

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

After 33% of the entry fee is retained by CCCI to cover expenses, the balance in each class will be distributed as follows:

CCCI NATIONAL • 4 - 6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four (4) months of age and over but under six (6) months on the day of the event. The winner of this competition will be named Best Four to Six Month Puppy in Show.

An AKC registration number of AKC litter will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed.

A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the county of orgin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Professional handers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling for pay. Do may not exhibited by current assistants and household member of a professional handler.

Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition

AKC rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at the competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, fogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth, etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6Month Puppy Classes.

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory to AKC conformation events. Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Winners of the Best of Breed will be award point toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their breed or variety. Winners of Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will be award defeated in their breed or variety. Winners of Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will be awarded points toward the CM title based on number of dogs defeated in their sex. The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following point structure

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in an Open Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an open class with competition to be eligible to enter the limited class competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1—October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

Juniors with a Dog also entered in another class offered at this show who substitute a dog not entered in this show must remit the Difference between junior only and junior who have entered junior showmanship only who then substitute another dog will not be charged a further fee.

NO PRACTICING IN THE RINGS BEFORE OR AFTER THE SHOW

AKC NATIONAL-OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members, and current assistants to professional handlers to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See Point Schedule). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
