SOCIAL DISTANCING

I will, to the best of my ability, practice proper social distancing as recommend by the State of Ohio "Stay Safe" directives, as well as practice good hygiene (hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, wearing of a mask if and when required, etc.) and follow other health recommendations. I will not sit in groups closer than 6 feet and will practice social distancing at all times.

HEALTH REPORTING:

- I have not experienced new or worsening symptoms of possible COVID-19 in the last 14 days, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a temperature greater than 100.4. I have not had close contact with a person symptomatic or confirmed to have COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- I have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days. If I have been infected by COVID-19 at any time, I have been medically released to return to normal activities.
- If I develop a fever and symptoms, such as a cough or difficulty breathing, or if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of this event, I will report this information to Cincinnati Kennel Club.
- Should symptoms develop during the event, I will report symptoms to Cincinnati County Kennel Club/Show Management and immediately leave the event.

COVID-19 Operating Guidelines

The Cincinnati Kennel Club, Inc., Organizers will work with state and local governments and public health authorities prior to the start of the our cluster to determine risks and mitigation measures.

On Site Process and Procedures

Cincinnati Kennel Club, Inc. shall require temperature monitoring for volunteers, officials, exhibitors, and service providers once daily prior to entering the show grounds. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to enter the grounds.

Everyone entering show grounds will be required to wear a mask. Signage to this effect will be posted at the entrance and throughout the grounds.

The following individuals will not be permitted on the show grounds:

- An individual who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms,
- An individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks, or
- An individual who has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks.

The Cincinnati Kennel Club, Inc. will post signage that displays all applicable federal, state and local regulations, requirements and orders as well as who recommendations and CDC guidelines as they relate to mass gatherings and sporting events in effect at the show.

Signage will be posted at all entrances to the show grounds which identifies the symptoms of COVID-19 and states the following:

- To protect others from possible transmission of the virus, anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks (exception, healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical-grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties), cannot enter the show grounds. These individuals are encouraged to contact their health care provider immediately for further medical advice and must obtain documented clearance from their health care provider before entering the show grounds. Participants must assume responsibility for themselves and their own staff (e.g. assistants, etc.).
- Recommendations about good hygiene along with informing participants and others about ways to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission.

Social Distancing & Limiting Entries

The Cincinnati Kennel Club, Inc. shall enforce social distancing requirements throughout the show grounds at all times.

- Prohibit the public, spectators, and non-essential personnel such as guests from being on the show grounds.
- Organize dog and exhibitor arrivals and departures to limit contact between people, (e.g. show time is 10 am, must leave the area immediately after you show and cannot return unless you have another dog to show in another time slot)

- Arrange judges' and other officials' areas to comply with social distancing requirements.
- Restrict show office and judges area access to essential personnel only. Limited entry will be considered if necessary.
- There will be no extra activities (raffles, puppy match, Barbeque)
- Regardless of the scope of the limitation, the limiting of entries must be done on a first come, first served basis and relevant information will be posted on the Show secretary's website.
- Configure grooming to comply with social distancing requirements.

Enforcement Authority

Stewards, Club members, and AKC officials will inform individuals when they are not in compliance with the regulations and requirements in effect at the show and shall report such situations to the Club Officials and AKC. The Cincinnati Kennel Club has the authority to remove from the facility any person who does not comply with the regulations and requirements in effect.

If an individual needs an accommodation under the American Disabilities Act, request should be submitted, along with documentation of the disability and need for accommodation, to Nina Fetter, Executive Dog Shows. Requests for accommodations will be reviewed on a confidential basis with a medical consultant.

Participants are required to comply with these and any additional Show Organizer requirements at all times while present on show grounds. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from the grounds. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from the grounds. These requirements are in effect immediately and until further notice, however, they are subject to revisions as the COVID-19 environment changes.

- Arrange judges' and other officials' areas to comply with social distancing requirements.
- Restrict show office and judges area access to essential personnel only. Limited entry will be considered if necessary.
- There will be no extra activities (raffles, puppy match, Town Hall meeting)
- Regardless of the scope of the limitation, the limiting of entries must be done on a first come, first served basis and relevant information will be posted on the Show secretary's website. Configure grooming to comply with social distancing requirements.

BEST RECOMMEND PRACTICES FOR COVID-19

The following Recommended Best Practices have been provided to assist Show Organizers with determining risks and developing measures to mitigate those risks:

- Limit the number of entrances and exits to the show area to manage the number of individuals accessing the show grounds. All entrances and exits must be manned to limit access.
- Communication – Use radio, cell phone communication methods as much as possible and communicate important information frequently throughout the show grounds.

Ring Procedure

- All dogs enter on one side of the ring and exit on the other side
- Dogs will stand in the designated line, when the judge is examining the dog, the exhibitor and dog will move up to the next line and do their individual movement and return to the end of the line. The judge will point to the dog for its placement while standing in the lines (spaced 6 feet away from the other dogs). Provide markers to delineate 6 feet spacing between people in any waiting lines (i.e., markers on floor).

Armbands Procedure

- The armband will be handed out at the stewards tables at the ring.

Waiver and Wristband Table

- There will be an entrance to the building and an exit to keep distancing.
- Please do not gather in the building.
- We will collect the Waivers and issue wristbands near the show secretary's office.

Parking Considerations

Parking area will be maintained completely separate from show area. RV parking is separate from regular auto parking. Parking area is no less than 6 feet from show area.

RV's will be parked no less than 15 feet apart. They will all be parked facing the same direction to ensure maximum separation of RV entrance/exits.

Automobiles will be parked in a separate area and will be parked no less than 6 feet apart.

There will be no gatherings of any kind at any time allowed in any parking area.

Considerations for Club Members, Medical Personnel, Service Providers & Volunteers

- Cleaning/Sanitizing Locations will be stationed in the building.
- Provide hand sanitization stations with access to soap and water or alcohol based hand sanitizer at several areas through the grounds.
- Provide hand sanitizer to all officials, ring crew, clean up and medical officials.
- Ensure frequent cleaning and sanitizing of bathrooms, provide soap and water or alcohol based hand sanitizer in bathrooms.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

Saturday, May 29, 2021 & Sunday, May 30, 2021

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition.

Classes will be offered for Breeds & Varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class Breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous Class competition will be equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS Competition will be the equivalent of Group Competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS Number of FSS Registered Litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS Breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for reexamination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of merit points may be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears and tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed. *Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at the competition. All applicable rules found in Rules to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.*

The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/handler's handling ability is not of consideration.

- There is no additional fee to enter this competition.
- Entries must be marked as eligible to compete in the AKC NOHS prior to the closing of entries for that show.
- Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any during the cluster/weekend.
- Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.
- Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competition.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all member of the same household.
- Dog declared eligible must be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the judge's book, steward's book, and the show catalog. The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winner of the non-regular show. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition and the regular show Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition and both the select Dog and Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner-handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in *Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner-Handled Best of Breed.*
- If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition. Owner-Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the breed/variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, Owner-Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded and the breed/variety will not be represented in group competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.

USE OF RAMPS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotti Romagnolo, Spaniels (American Water), Spaniels (Clumber), Spaniels (English Springer), Spaniels (Field), Spaniels (Welsh Springer), Cirneco dell'Etna, Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terrier, Irish Terrier, Kerry Blue Terrier, Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdog, Spanish Water Dog, Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Spaniels (Boykin) and Whippets.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the a ramp, or on a table: Mudi (Misc.).

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Spaniels (Sussex), Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, and Chow Chows.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In emergency situations where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. **Please Check www.AKC.org for updates to this list.**

Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11, section 1.

The dog show rules are posted on the AKC web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>.

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor Class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period for 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf>.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of \$.50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$40 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.
