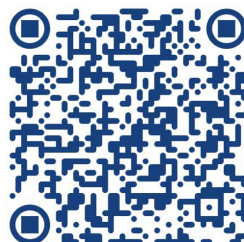

REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

The Chihuahua Club of America, Inc. Sweepstakes is open to all Chihuahuas that, on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. No Champions of Record may be entered in the Sweepstakes. Dogs shows in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches, in each Variety.

- Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos ▪ Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos,
- Junior, 12 Mos & Under 18 Mos

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

35% of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided in each class as follows:

- 1st - 40% ▪ 2nd - 30% ▪ 3rd - 20% ▪ 4th - 10%

Any money not awarded due to absentees, will be retained by the club.

The Chihuahua Club of America, Inc. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Chihuahuas that, on the day of the show, will be 7 years of age & older. Champions of Record may be entered in the Sweepstakes. Dog shows in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches, in each Variety.

- Veteran, 7 Years & Under 9 Years ▪ Veteran, 9 Years & Over

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

35% of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided in each class as follows:

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

Amateur-Owner-Handler: (AOH Class Eligibility) For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Bred-By-Exhibitor Class eligibility: (BBE Class Eligibility) All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC. For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. The Person handling the dog must be individually registered with American Kennel Club and are owned or co-owned by any of the breeders as of the date of closing entries for this show. The person handling the dog in the class must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Best of Breed: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Also, dogs that, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose records are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championship is unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date when the dog completed the requirements for a championship, according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until his championship has been confirmed by AKC.

POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE AT THE NATIONAL SPECILATY

The Chihuahua Club of America, Inc. will award at the National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch if the Regular Class Dog/Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE AT THE REGIONAL SPECILATY

The Chihuahua Club of America, Inc. will award at the Regional Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch if the Regular Class Dog/Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the Regional Specialty is held.

CLASSIFICATION & ELIGIBILITY

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog & Bitch Entries

Veteran Dog Class (7 Years & Under 9 Years) • A Class for Dogs seven (7) years & under nine (9) years if age.

Veteran Dog Class (9 Years & Over) • A Class for Dogs nine (9) years & over.

Veteran Bitch Class (7 Years & Under 9 Years) • A Class for Bitches seven (7) years & under nine (9) years if age.

Veteran Bitch Class (9 Years & Over) • A Class for Bitches nine (9) years & over.

NEUTERED DOGS & SPAYED BITCHES MAY ENTER VETERAN CLASSES, BRACE, STUD DOG, & BROOD BITCH AT THESE SPECIALTIES.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Note: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class • For Stud Dogs and minimum of two, maximum of four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition. The Stud dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class • Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

AKC Rules Applying to Dog shows, Chapter 11, Section 8, provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class • For two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. At least one dog must be entered in another class. PLEASE indicate on the entry forms as to which dog (s) are to make up the entry in each Brace. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dog comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace No 1", "Brace No 2", etc.

This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Competition • During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Best Veteran Competition • During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran class is awarded Best of Winner or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Grand Champion Points • Grand Championship points will be awarded to: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch.

3 Point Major Reserve • At the National Specialty & Regional Specialty, a dog designated Reserve Winners Dog or Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

Judge's Award of Merit • Regional & National • Immediately following the Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed awards are made. The judge may select, at his/her discretion the Award of Merits; all dogs remaining in the competition are eligible for an Award of Merit. The number of awards are determined by the size of the entry in Best of Variety 2-10 entries = 1 Award of Merit, 11- 20 entries = 2 Awards of Merit, 21-30 entries = 3 Awards of Merit, 31- 40 entries = 4 Awards of Merit, & 41 or more entries = 5 Awards of Merits.

AKC NATIONAL-OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members, and current assistants to professional handlers to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Best Owner-Handled (BOH). The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show.

The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner-Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See Point Schedule). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. Dogs that finished ranked in the top ten (plus ties) for their breed during the qualifying period will be invited to compete in the competition. Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in an Open Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an open class with competition to be eligible to enter the limited class competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1—October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Competition must exist for Best Junior Handler.

The Pee is Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class geared to children 5 years old and under 9 years of age at all shows offering Pee Wee.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is no a competitive class, but rather a run, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four month of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club may be substituted.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release forms will be available at the show.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside a outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentor-ing experience - no Junior will be judged, but rather will be mentored with the age-appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time.

Each child will receive a participation ribbon to commemorate the experience!

The Judge should explain the process of showing the dog to the Junior and the responsible adult in the ring including breed specific presentation. Depending on the size of the dog and the child, the adult may be asked to lift a table breed on or off of the table, or the Club may mandate that the adult should do it regardless. Neither the youngster nor the adult should be asked to show the bite.

In addition to an entry, a release ,must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release form will be available at the Club Table.

MAX HURD SPECIAL EXHIBITION CLASS

CCA GUIDELINE FOR HOTEL/MOTEL MAINTNANCE

- Time of Arrival: after 4:00pm ▪ Departure Time: by 11:00am
 - The individual guest will be responsible for any damage to a guest room or any hotel property. This includes, but not limited to, replacement cost of carpeting, bedding, comforters etc. if odors or stains cannot be removed with traditional cleaning methods.
 - Dogs are to be leashed at all times when out of the guest room.
 - The hotel and the show committee will investigate any problem areas that are outlined above. Any guest not following the above guidelines will be asked to check out of the hotel without refund.
 - The Hotel has requested that dogs will not be allowed in the following public areas: the lobby, restaurant, lounge, foyers, and their respective hallways to the areas listed.
 - There will be a \$100.00 fee for any removal of guest room furniture. All furniture must remain in the room at all times.
 - Room assignment is at the discretion of the hotel. This basis is in reference to the date the room was reserve, not the date the guest arrives.
 - Our hotel cannot guarantee any special request. We will, however, try our best to meet your wishes.
 - Because some dog people have been irresponsible in safeguarding property of hotels, it is increasingly difficult to secure suitable housing for our shows, our members, and our dogs. For this reason CCA is issuing the following guidelines for exhibitors to ensure that we are welcomed at hotels/motels.
1. If dogs are exercised in the rooms, this must be done in exercise pens. Do not block the bathroom or closet, to accomplish this. To set up exercise pens, use heavy plastic as a base, with multiple layers of newspaper and/or potty pads, absorbent material on top, then place the exercise pen on top of the absorbent material. NO SHAVINGS, PELLETS OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL OTHER THAN PAPER OR POTTY PADS WILL BE ALLOWED. The heavy plastic is pulled above the "piddle" line about 8 to 10 inches and secured with clips or clothespins. Soiled papers must be removed and placed in plastic bags for ease of disposal. Do not expect the housekeepers to have to touch any soiled papers and soiled papers must not be merely placed in the wastepaper baskets, as a scent of excreta and urine will penetrate the wastebaskets. All rooms must be kept clean and smell clean. This protects curtains and furniture.
 2. When dogs are left alone in the rooms, they must be left in their individual crates. Even dogs that generally don't climb, have been known to climb out of their exercise pens when left in strange areas and dogs have dug their way through their plastic and continued digging through the carpeting. This requirement of keeping dogs in their crates protects the animals from escaping while housekeepers come in, and of course, protects the furnishings.
 3. Dogs must not be allowed to run free in the room, whether the owner is present or not. Many a good dog becomes suddenly unhousebroken when it encounter strange odors in strange places.
 4. Owners/exhibitors should bring their own toweling for bathing the dogs. Hotel/motel equipment must not be used for cleaning up accidents, owners/exhibitors must provide their own cleanup material...paper towels, vinegar, fantastic and the like.
 5. Most hotels/motels that permit the use of their facilities for dog shows have a policy limiting the number of dogs per room. **There will be a maximum of 6 dogs per room.**
 6. No dogs will be allowed on any carpeting, including lobby rugs, halls, guest rooms, show rooms, etc.
 7. No exercising of dogs in any area, except those areas posted with signs as dog areas. Each person is responsible for cleaning up after their dog, inside and outside of the motel.
 8. No dogs allowed outside their crates, unless in an ex-pen with plastic or in the show ring.
 9. No dogs allowed in the lounge, lobby, banquet/meeting rooms and restaurant.
 10. Dogs MUST BE carried in and out through designated exits/entrances only.
 11. The only breed of dog that is allowed in the hotel will be Chihuahuas. No other animals will be allowed.
 12. Rooms must be made available for maids to clean daily. Do not disturb signs will not be honored during the day.

- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

Show, Obedience Trial or Rally. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee are to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 1, Section 4). All Recording Fees payable to the American Kennel Club.

All exhibitors will wear a mask if the presiding Judge is wearing a mask.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of **\$40.00** will be made for each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.
