At a specialty show the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five-point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.

TRANSFER POLICY FOR THE SPECIALTIES AND TRIALS: The Clubs will permit a transfer to the next level class in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a transfer must be made in writing and presented to the Superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the specified event, show or trial. Transfer forms will be available at the Superintendent's table.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran (7-10 years): For dogs & bitches at least seven (7) years of age and under ten (10) years of age the day of the show.

Veteran (10 years & older): For dogs & bitches at least ten (10) years of age and older the day of the show.

Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated are eligible for Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (ACCC National Specialty Only)

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered as Stud Dog & spayed females may be entered as the Brood Bitch.

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving multiple dog entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS—For Stud dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership of the Stud Dog. The Stud dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the place- ment of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a con- dition that would require its disqualification or excusal under AKC Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard of the breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS—Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS—Two dogs with at least one or more common owner. The two dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Class, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated "Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2", etc. First place only to be awarded. A Rosette will be awarded to First Place.

Please designate the other members of the Brace on the entry form for each dog AWARDS OF MERIT (Where offered)

At the discretion of the judge, up to five (5) Awards of Merit may be awarded in the Best of Breed judging. The Winners of Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are to be selected first and those winners are not eligible for Awards of Merit. A rosette will be given to each Award of Merit winner.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 years · Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 years Novice Senior 15 & under 18 years · Open Junior 9 & under 12 years Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 years Open Senior 15 & under 18 years · Master Class

Novice Class—Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or members show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class—Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class—Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your Junior identification number by calling the AKC Judges Education Department at (919) 233-9767.

SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES (ACCC Regional & National Specialty Only)

Division of Prize Money Applies to Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes 35% of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

First	30% of the total entry fees for each class
Second	20% of the total entry fees for each class
Third	10% of the total entry fees for each class
Fourth	5% of the total entry fees for each class

In cases where less than 4 specimens are shown, the payout will be determined as if the four were shown and the undistributed money shall accrue to the club.

SWEEPSTAKES REOUIREMENT & CLASSIFICATION

Sweepstakes is open to all Chinese Cresteds that are 6 months & under 18 months of age on the day of the show. No Champion of Record can be entered in sweepstakes. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes need to be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided.

Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided.

The dog and its owner will continue to accrue points for any group placements or Bests in Show. The top-ranked dogs from the AKC National Owner- Handled Series are posted on the AKC National Owner-Handled Series Points Ranking page. Rankings of the dogs competing in the Series are compiled based on the Best of Breed, Group, and Best in Show placements in this specific Series competition (See Point Schedule). The end of year competition for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series will be held in conjunction with the AKC show in December. 





AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsman-ship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and com-panion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might
 reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than
 the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS

A Recording Fee of .50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Returned Checks / Invalid Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$45 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Superintendent.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 processing fee per entry.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

To find out about any AKC event cancellations, call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229. Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor the Superintendent will be responsible for obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
